
IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR CARRIERS !!!

A PRE-MANDATORY REPORTING OF DATA FROM THE TIR CARNET DURING ITS INITIAL TRIGGER IS IMPLEMENTED

From 1 January 2009 an amending of the Customs Code of the European Union /EU/, enters into force, which requires mandatory pre-declaration data of the TIR Carnet in its initial trigger / at the office / EU or upon entering the territory of the Community /office at the entrance/.

Obligation of each carrier on presentation of TIR Carnet for processing at the departure or input office of the EU is to be already submitted data in the new computerized transit system - NCTS.

What does it mean for carriers, using the TIR carnet (EU and third countries)

- Mandatory electronic reporting of the TIR Carnet in the NCTS system of customs agents and forwarding agents.
(Still required submission of paper carnet TIR)
- Lack of representation of electronic TIR declaration led to the rejection of the TIR Carnet (only exception is if NCTS does not work)

- Quick completion of the TIR operation in the EU (electronic communication between customs officials)
- Better monitoring and greater security of the TIR transport
